- **Given** the resolution n.05.03 dated 25th February 2021 issued by the Board of Directors approving the above mentioned public selection;

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Art. 1

Scope of the public selection

A public selection, by qualifications and public interview, has launched for recruiting 1 (one) technologist in order to carry out activities of technical and administrative support for research activities, with a temporary 36-months contract - Ctg. D - Economic Position D3 at the Department of Engineering, under the scheme of the project "Achieving wider uptake of water-smart solutions, Wider-Uptake - Horizon 2020, GA n. 869283 - Project code PRJ-0132, CUP B71C19000420006".

The work program is aimed at carrying out technical and administrative support as follows:

- Administrative support in Horizon 2020 projects management;
- Drafting and filling in of activity projects documents, mid-term and financial reports, final reports, communication flow and activities with Funding Organizations;
- Organizational support for events and meetings;
- activities related to the communication with project Partners and Interested Parties;
- participation in the meetings with EU funding Agencies, EU Commission and National Contact Offices;
- Funding opportunities scouting acitivites.

The economic treatment is that foreseen for a contract Ctg. D - Economic Position D3, equal to \in 21.692,79 per year to the 50%, including all the legal charges but except for the additional payment, in compliance with art. 24 bis - 4th paragraph, of the Law 240/2010.

The amount will be covered under the Project Achieving wider uptake of water-smart solutions, Wider-Uptake - Horizon 2020, GA n. 869283 - Project code PRJ-0132, CUP B71C1900042000 - COAN: CA.C.B.03.05.13 "Salaries and other fixed costs addressed to the technical-administrative staff with a fixed term employment.



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Place of work: Department of Engineering. Contract duration: 36 months – 18 hours per week.



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Art. 2 Admission requirements

The selection is open to:

- a) Applicants graduated in Economics Degree code LM/56;
- b) Applications with a Professional qualification: at least 2 years' working experience in a Public Administration Offices and/or in Private Organizations; in relation to the activities to be carried out under this public notice;

and Applicants with the following requirements:

Italian citizenship or citizenship of another Member State of the European Union or their family members who do not have the citizenship of a Member State, provided that they are holders of the right of residence or the right of permanent residence, as well as citizens of third countries who are holders of the residence permit. EC residence for long-term residents or holders of refugee status or subsidiary protection status;

enjoyment of political rights;

fitness for this vacancy

being in compliance with the regulations concerning military service obligations for those born by 1985;

being not less than 18 years old

For qualifications obtained abroad, applicants have to submit the needed certifications, stating the equivalence to the Italian qualifications, pursuant to Legislative Decree. N.165/2001 and/or the statement starting the request for the equivalence to the qualifications, according to the procedure in the art. 38 of Legislative Decree 165/2001 (http://www.funzionepubblica.gov.it/strumenti-e-controlli/modulistica).

The selection is not open to and otherwise shall be excluded:

- 1) those who have been excluded from the enjoyment of civil and political rights;
- 2) those who have been dismissed or exempted from an employment in a Public Administration's office because of insufficient performance, and/or dismissed from any other public engagement, according to the article 127 subsection 1 lett. d) of D.P.R. 10.1.1957, no. 3;
- 3) those who have criminal convictions, or any criminal convictions reported, and any pending criminal proceedings against him/her.

Candidates who have received criminal convictions must indicate the date of the sentence, the authority that issued it, the nature of the offense, even if a pardon, amnesty, etc. have been released and even if nothing appears from the criminal personal record. Pending criminal procedures must also be indicated, whatever their nature.

According to the article 18 subsection 1) lett. B and C - Law 240/2010, as amended and updated, and according to article 7, subsection 1 and 2 of the Ethics code, the selection is not open to any person who is related by marriage or by blood up to the fourth degree, to a professor working in the Department in charge of the vacancy, or the structure proposing the activation of the contract, or to the Rector, General Director, or a member of the Board of Governors of the University.

Foreign citizens must also hold the following requirements:

- 1) enjoyment of civil and political rights even in the States of belonging or origin;
- 2) all the other requirements envisaged for citizens of the Italian Republic, with the exception of the Italian citizenship;
- 3) Italian proper knowledge.

The admission requirements, as defined in this call for application, must be held at the submission deadline. The Administration guarantees equal opportunities between women and men for accessing to work and treatment in the workplace.



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Art. 3

How to apply

Applicants must submit their application form, online, via <u>https://servizisia.unipa.it/concorsi</u>, filling in the foreseen template.

The deadline for the submission of the application form is the thirtieth (30th) day after the official publication of the call on the <u>Gazzetta Ufficiale della Repubblica Italiana, Quarta Serie Speciale Concorsi ed</u> <u>Esami</u>, at 14.00 (2pm) (Italian local time), otherwise shall be excluded.

In order to complete the application form, applicants <u>must hold</u> a personal certified email account (PEC) where all the information will be sent. Third parties certified email (PEC) accounts, companies or legal entities email PEC accounts are not allowed.

For foreign candidates, the personal certified email account PEC is not mandatory. <u>Ordinary personal email</u> account is allowed.

After having filled in the application form, the applicants will receive a confirmation email proving the submission. This receipt must be kept and showed, if requested.

As soon as applicants complete the submission, the system will release a code automatically: the code must be used for any subsequent communication.

The date of electronic submission of the application form to participate in the selection is certified by the computer system which will no longer allow access and sending of the electronic form, upon expiry of the deadline for its submission.

Within the deadline, applicants can modify the application. Certifications and other documents can be attached in the system

Candidates are requested to pay a contribution equal to € 10,00, otherwise shall be excluded.

Copy of the bank transfer must be attached to the application form.

Under their own responsibility, the applicants must declare, filling in the online application form:

- name and surname;
- place and date of birth;
- social security number fiscal code number (only for Italian citizens);
- residence and domicile;
- certified email address PEC only for the Italian citizens;
- email address (for foreign citizens);
- telephone number;
- degree certificate and/or master's degree;
- equivalent degree or equivalent qualification obtained abroad and recognized in accordance with the relevant provisions in force;
- Specific working and professional experience (at least 2 years):
- English knowledge;
- Citizenship (Italians not belonging to the Republic are equivalent to citizens of the Italian State);
- for Italian nationals: the electoral lists where enrolled or otherwise the reasons for the cancellation or the failure to register;
- if foreign citizens: the full enjoyment of civil and politics rights otherwise the reason for the failure of enjoyment;
- only for Italian citizens: the current position regarding military obligations



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- to have no criminal convictions, or any criminal convictions reported, indicating the details of the relative sentences (even if amnesty, amnesty, pardon or court pardon was released) and any pending criminal proceedings against him/her;
- not to have been dismissed or exempted from an employment in a Public Administration's office because of insufficient performance, and/or dismissed from any other public engagement, according to the article 127 subsection 1 lett. d) of D.P.R. 10.1.1957, no. 3;
- only for foreign citizens: proper knowledge of the Italian language
- to have possible preferential qualifications as set forth in art. 10 of this public notice, if placed in the merit ranking with the same score of another candidate;
- not to have a degree of kinship or affinity, up to and including the fourth degree, with a professor belonging to the department or structure that carries out the call or with the Rector, the General Director or a member of the Board of the University.

The Administration reserves the right to carry out checks on the truthfulness of the declarations, self-certifications and substitute declarations, according to the DPR 445/2000 and following amendments.

Candidates certified as disable pursuant to the Law 104/1992, as amended and modified and to the Law 68/1999, may ask for the benefits as foreseen in the laws, mentioning it in the application form. Namely, it must be specified the needed support for attending the tests in relation to one's own condition, as well as the possible need for additional time for carrying out the examination tests. In such situations, they will have to produce suitable medical-health certification that specifies the essential elements relating to their condition, in order to allow the Administration to prepare tools and instruments to guarantee all they need in time.

Failure to indicate in the application of the necessary aids automatically make the Administration free of any obligations.

Along with the application form, the candidates must attach, signed, scanned and saved in pdf file,

- copy of a valid ID document;
- only for the Italians: copy of the health insurance card and/or fiscal code card;
- curriculum vitae duly signed;
- certifications proving the specific working/professional experience;
- other documents and certifications and statements;
- Copy of the bank transfer equal to € 10,00, as proof of the participation's contribution reporting CRO/TRN codes.

According to the Italian Law, the possess of the qualifications can be certified with a self-statement as per the art. 46 or per the art. 47 of the D.P.R. 445/2000, mentioning all the detailed information required and needed for the assessment procedure.

It is strictly forbidden to mention publications and/or copy of qualifications already submitted to this University or to other Public Administrations/Institutions.

Documents can be scanned by an original, a certified copy or by a copy declared in compliance with the original one by a substitutive declaration, pursuant to art. 47 of the D.P.R. n. 445/2000.

Only the data and documents in the possession of the University of Palermo can be acquired automatically if the candidate indicates the indispensable elements for finding the information or data requested.

All the above-mentioned documents must be scanned and sent along with a <u>separate statement</u>, certifying the documents are equal to the original ones and are in compliance with the original copies, according to the art. 47 -- D.P.R. n. 445/2000.

As stated in the art. 15 of the <u>law 12.11.2011 n. 183</u>, the certifications issued by the Public Administration regarding status, personal qualities and facts, are valid only in relations between private individuals, starting from 01.01.2012.

In the relations with Public administration bodies and Public services providers, certificates are always replaced by statements, released according to the articles 46 and 47 of the D.P.R. n. 445/2000.

In relation to administrative documentations, citizens of a non-EU country must comply with the requirements foreseen in art. 3, subsections 2, 3 and 4 of the D.P.R. n. 445/2000.

Owned qualifications and statements, written in another foreign language than English, French, German and Spanish, must be translated in Italian, and certified as conforming by the competent Italian diplomatic either by consular offices or by a sworn translator.



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The Administration reserves the right to carry out checks on the truthfulness of the declarations, self-certifications and substitute declarations. In the event of fake statements, the provisions in articles 483, 485 and 486 of the penal code will be applied.

Art. 4

Exclusion from the selection procedure

The exclusion, due to the lack of one of the requirements can be decided at any time during the procedure, by a duly motivated Decree, issued by the Rector and notified to the interested party by PEC (for the Italian ones) or by registered letter with return receipt for foreign candidates.

In any case, candidates will be excluded for:

- lack of admission requirements pursuant to art. 2 of this announcement;

- failure to submit the online application form;
- transmission of the application beyond the deadline, set by the notice;
- failure to pay the contribution equal to € 10,00;

- sending the application by a not personal email and/or not personal certified email (PEC).

Art. 5 Pre-selection Test

In relation to the number of candidates, the Administration reserves the right to proceed with a possible preselection test. Date and place of the preselection test will be published on the official Register of the University (see art. 18), no less than 7 days before the test. No other communication will be given.

Pursuant to Article 2 - bis of Law 104/1992 and to Law no. 114/2014, the disadvantaged candidate, suffering from a disability equal to or greater than 80%, is not required to participate in the preselection test.

Candidates will be excluded if they do not participate in the preselection tests.

The score obtained in the preselected test does not contribute to the final mark. The results will be published as detailed in the following art. 18, anonymously and with the code produced by the system during the submission form's procedures.

Candidates placed in the first 10 places and any *ex aequo* in the last position will be admitted to the following selection tests.

The Administration will verify the possession of the requirements for access to the procedure only for those who have passed the pre-selection test.

During the pre-selection test, candidates will not be able neither to bring books, periodicals, newspapers, newspapers and publications nor bags for containing the above material, which must in any case be delivered, before the test, to the surveillance staff, who will return them at the end of the test, without assuming any responsibility for their content.

The use of electronic equipment (computers, mobile phones, smartphones, smartwatches or tablets) will also not be allowed, otherwise excluded.

During the pre-selection test, candidates will not be able to communicate with each other or outside in any way, under penalty of immediate exclusion from the competition.

In the event that the aforementioned preselection is not carried out or in the case of postponement of the same, notice will be given, at least 2 days before the scheduled date, by means of a notice published in the Official Register of the University and at the address given in the following art 18.

This communication will be valid as an official notification

Art. 6

Assessment general criteria

Pursuant to article 8 of the Regulations for the Fixed-Term Technologist; a score of 30 points is reserved for the qualification evaluation. If relevant for the activities (technical and administrative support activity to the research activities), the qualifications are evaluated as follows:

More than 2 years' working experience in a Public Administration offices / Private Organizaitons	Until 15 points
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ECDL (European Computer Driving License), MOS	Until 5 points
(Master Microsoft Office Specialist), Eipass	
(European Informatics Passport) and /or equivalent	
Other academic qualifications: other degrees	Until 10 points

The selection committee will proceed with the qualifications assessment, only for the candidates admitted to the written test and only before evaluating the papers, produced by the candidates. The results will be published on the Official University Register and on http://www.unipa.it/amministrazione/arearisorseumane/settorereclutamentoeselezioni/PersonaleTA/tecnologi

For each candidate, the Commission draws up a summary document report, integral part of the minutes where the qualifications relating to the various categories and the corresponding scores will be mentioned. The assessment qualifications results will be published before the oral test /interview, with restricted access, on the website as per the following art. 18.

Art. 7 Selection Committee

The selection committee is appointed with a Decree issued by the Rector. It's made up of 3 members chosen from *First Level* University Professors, Second *Level* University Professors and researchers, also not belonging to the University of Palermo, upon proposal of the Department.

The designation decree is published on the Official University Register.

Within thirty days from the publication of the Rector Decree appointing the committee, candidates may submit to the Rector of the University petitions/complaints against the member of the selection committees, when there are the circumstances foreseen by the art. 51 and 52 of the Italian Civil Code of Civil Procedure. If the cause for the objection has arisen, as long as it is prior to the date on which the commission is established, the term starts from its onset. The petitioner's procedure is not allowed anymore, when the mentioned deadline has passed and, in any case, after the setting-up of the selection commission.

Art. 8

Selection committee's fulfilments

The first meeting of the selection committee is requested and asked by the President, afters 30 days from the date of publication of the appointment's decree on the University's Official Register. The Committee in the above-mentioned meeting will:

 enter in the minutes a declaration released by each member and stating the nonexistence of the causes of abstention pursuant to arts. 51 and 52 of the Italian Code of civil procedure;

- establish the criteria for the preliminary evaluation of the candidates (Ministerial Decree 05/25/2011 n. 243);
- establish the criteria to be used for the acknowledgment of a score to the qualifications and to each publication sent by the candidates, admitted to the discussion;
- view the list of candidates and enter in the minutes a statement affirming that there are no abstentions pursuant to Articles 51 and 52 of the code of civil procedure between candidates and committees' members.

At the end of the first meeting, the minutes is sent to the Officer in charge of the procedure, in order to ensure the required publicity on the University's Official Register, at least for seven days, before the next and coming selection Committee section.

After the possible pre-selection test and however before the written tests, according to the art. 2 of this announcement, the selection committee will have to evaluate the accessing requirements of candidates who have passed the preselection test, whose applications will be transmitted in electronic format by the Officer



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in charge of the procedures. In the event that the aforementioned preselection test is not carried out, the accessing requirements will be checked before the written tests.

The proceedings of the selection procedure consist of the selection Committee minutes. The Commission must conclude all the selection phases within three (3) months from the date of the Rector's appointment decree. In the event that the works are not finalised within the previously mentioned terms, with a motivated decision, the Rector can launch the procedure to replace the whole Commission or the members of the committee, to which the causes of the delay are due, establishing at the same time a new deadline for the conclusion of the procedures.

Art. 9

Selection Tests

The procedure includes the following recruitment process: two written tests and a public discussion/interview (oral test).

The first and second written or practical tests, for candidates passing any pre-selection phase, will focus on the topics as indicated in the art. 1 of this public notice. The oral test will focus on the same topics as the written or practical tests.

During the public discussion/interview, knowledge of the University Statute will also be ascertained, as well as an excellent English knowledge, as well as computer programs related to the activities envisaged by the work program.

The selection committee will provide a total score equal to 120 points shared as follows:

• 30 points to first written test

• 30 points to second practical test

• 30 points to public discussion/interview (oral test).

• 30 points to the provided qualifications.

The written tests will be considered passed, if the candidate has reported a score of at least 21/30 in each of them. The interview is considered passed with a vote of at least 21/30.

Date and venue of the selections tests will be published on the Official University Registry and on the websites reported in the following art.18. No other communication will be given.

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Any communication about dates' modifications will be published, on the Official Register of the University and at the website reported in art. 18.

If a candidate will not join the tests sections, she/he will be excluded, regardless the reason.

The list of candidates, reporting the obtained scores and the probable admission to the oral test will be published on the University online register and on the website http://www.unipa.it/istruzione/arearisorseumane / settorereclutamentoeselezioni / PersonaleTA / tecnologi.

The oral exam will take place in a classroom open to the public with a suitable capacity to ensure maximum participation or, with an authorization, in a blended modality.

At the end of each session dedicated to the oral test, the Commission will report the list of evaluated candidates mentioning marks obtained by each of them.

Candidates must show only one of the following valid identification documents, for joining the evaluation sections:

- ID card;
- firearms license;
- driving license;
- boat license;
- passport;

- identification cards issued by a State Administration.

The final score is given by the sum of the scores of the aforesaid tests and by qualifications assessment results.

At the end of the works, the selection committee will formulate the merit ranking of the candidates.

With the Rector's provision, the competition deeds/proceedings will be approved, along with the merit ranking and the winner's candidate.



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Art. 10 Priorities and Preferences

Within 15 days from the interview/public discussion, candidates, passing the oral test must send the documents certifying the possession of any qualifications, including priorities and/or preferences qualifications, as reported in the application form, by certified email (PEC) to the following email address pec@cert.unipa.it (for Nationals) and to mail-protocollo@unipa.it (for foreign candidates), mentioning the code released by the system during the application form procedure.

They also has to duly certify to hold those qualifications, at the deadline foreseen for submitting the application forms.

Documents, certifying to hold preferential qualifications, if candidates with the same evaluation can be scanned by an original, a certified copy or by a copy declared in compliance with the original one by a substitutive declaration, pursuant to art. 47 of the D.P.R. n. 445/2000.

In some circumstances, the scan may also refer to the substitutive declaration of certification pursuant to art. 46 or to art. 47 of the aforementioned decree.

False declarations are punishable under the Penal Code and under the related special laws on the matter. In some most serious events, they can cause temporary disqualification from public offices cases, without prejudice to the forfeiture of any benefits resulting from the provision issued on the basis of the untruthful declaration.

As far as candidates, with the same scores are concerned, propriety and preference will be given to:

- 1. military value awarded people;
- 2. ex-combatants mutilated and war disabled;
- 3. the disabled and disabled due to war;
- 4. the disabled and disabled for service in the public and private sector;
- 5. war orphans;
- 6. the orphans of the fallen due to war;
- 7. the orphans of the fallen for service in the public and private sector;
- 8. the wounded in combat;
- 9. the winners of war cross or other special attestation of merit of war, as well as the heads of numerous families;
- 10.the children of the mutilated and war-fighting ex-combatants;
- 11.the children of the maimed and disabled by war;
- 12.the children of disabled and disabled for service in the public and private sector;
- 13.widowed parents who have not remarried, spouses who have not remarried and widowed or unmarried brothers and sisters of war dead;
- 14. widowed parents who have not remarried, spouses who have not remarried and widowed or unmarried brothers and sisters of those who died because of war;
- 15. widowed parents who have not remarried, spouses who have not remarried and widowed or unmarried brothers and sisters of those who died for service in the public and private sector;
- 16.those who have performed commendable military service as combatants;
- 17.those who have given praiseworthy service for any reason, for not less than a year in the administration that has announced the competition;
- 18.married and unmarried with regard to the number of dependent children;
- 19. invalids and civilian mutilated;

20.military volunteers of the Armed Forces dismissed without demerit at the end of their service.

With equal merit and qualifications, priority will be given:

- according to the number of dependent children, regardless of whether the candidate is married or not;
- for having given praiseworthy service in public administrations;
- for being the younger candidates.



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Art. 11 Documents conformity and regularity checks

With his own decree, The Rector verifies the formal regularity of the documents, approves the proceedings and declares the name of the most qualified candidate to cover the vacancy, in relation to this call for recruitment along with the merit's ranking. Statements, facts and personal qualities self-certified by the winning candidate are subject to the University, checks.

The Decree will be published on the official University website and on www.unipa.it/amministrazione/arearisorseumane/settorereclutamentoeselezioni/PersonaleTA/tecnologi/.

Terms for any appeals will run from the date of publishing in the Official Register of the University. The merit ranking will be effective for the period foreseen by the current legislation.

Art. 12

Contract's signature

The declared winner candidate will be invited to sign a 36 months contract, by receiving a PEC or other communication, within ten days from the date of receipt of the communication sent by the Administration, otherwise excluded. In the event of failure to comply with the aforementioned deadline, the forthcoming candidate in the ranking will be invited to sign the contract.

The winner must submit the relevant documentation within thirty days from having been hired.

The winner will sign a temporary private-law contract -- subordinate employment - category D - economic position D3 with the University Administration and will receive a gross annual pay as foreseen under the current National Collective Labour Contract of the University's sector, in addition to the indemnity University and any other accessory fees if due.

The delay in sending/submitting the required documents or other documents different from those provided or irregularly completed, will entail the forfeiture of the relative benefits, without notice.

The envisaged trial period cannot be renewed or extended upon expiry. After half trial period, in the remaining period each party may withdraw from the contract, at any time without prior notice or indemnity in lieu of notice. The withdrawal operates when communicated to the counterpart. The administration's withdrawal must be justified.

Pursuant to art. 24 bis paragraph V, the contracts, ruled by the University Regulations for the establishment of the fixed-term Technologist, do not give the right to access the roles of the academic or technical - administrative staff of the Universities.

Art. 13

Termination of the contract

The contract shall be ended at the expiration date as foreseen in the contract or by right, by giving notice to the other party. Each of the contractors may terminate the contract, before the deadline, when a circumstance does not allow the prosecution of the contract, pursuant to art. 2119 of the civil code.

Art. 14

Economic terms

Pursuant to article 24 bis of the Law 240 dated 30.12.2010, the economic conditions, reserved to the technologist employed under this public notice, are equal to those foreseen for the staff employed under the contractual Economic Category D3.

Art. 15

Data Protection

The personal data, communicated by the candidates throughout the application, will be collected and processed by the University of Palermo in compliance with the EU Regulation n. 679/2016. The data communication is mandatory, otherwise excluded. The interested parties enjoy the rights as detailed in the abovementioned EU Regulation, including the right to access the data concerning him/her. These rights may
