Erasmus Mundus Projects

Erasmus Mundus Action 2 is a mobility programme between European and Third Country higher education institutions

- Mobility of students, selected on the basis of academic excellence, at all levels: Undergraduates, Master students, <u>PhD students and Post-Doctorates</u>
 - -> jointly supervised doctoral theses
- Mobility of academic and administrative staff (professors, researchers etc)
 - -> networking between laboratories
 - -> research on common thematic areas
 - -> exchange and transfer of knowledge (teaching methods)
- Mobilities of various lengths
 Possibility of exchanges or full degrees for students
- The Erasmus Mundus programme provides **scholarships** for European and Third country students and staff Monthly scholarship amount: L/M: 1 000€ PhD: 1 500€ PD: 1 800€ Staff: 2 500€
