### Special requirements for Bachelor students wishing to enter the double degree programme of FAU or UP.

- B1. Students wishing to enter the UP Laurea Triennale in Ingegneria Meccanica programme must have successfully completed all courses of year one and two of the bachelor degree in International Production Engineering and Management at FAU and must have acquired further 9 ECTS as practical training or further courses, for a total of 129 ECTS. In their final year at UP, the following courses must be completed, which equals a credit transfer of 51 ECTS:

Macchine – Machines	9
Attività di laboratorio CAD - CAM – Laboratories of CAD - CAM	3+3

The above courses will be given in English.

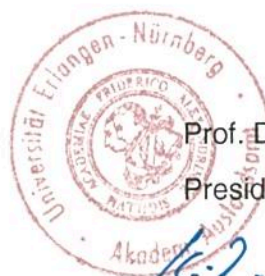

Students wishing to enter the FAU bachelor degree in International Production Engineering and Management programme must have successfully completed all courses of year one and two of the Laurea Triennale in Ingegneria Meccanica (curriculum meccanico) programme at UP and have already successfully completed the lecture “Macchine” for a total of 129 ECTS. In their final year at FAU, the following courses must be completed, which equals a credit transfer of 51 ECTS:
