On the 24th of September 2018, from 3pm to 7pm, at Palazzo Chiaramonte-Steri, in Sala delle Capriate, it is going to take place the international conference "Data and Law: future scenarios of the fight against organized crime. From Palermo to the world".

The convention is part of the "Semana i. Mafia y Cultura de la Legalidad: el caso Palermo" project, created in collaboration between the **Monterrey Institute of Technology and Higher Education** and the no-profit cultural association **Locus**, sustained by **Università di Palermo** and **Assemblea Regionale Siciliana**.

The event will be attended by an academic delegation from the prestigious Mexican University, as well as numerous cultural associations, institutions and international NGOs.
